ORDINANCE NO. 083-2026

APPROVING AND MAKING A FUND TRANSFER FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONIES IN THE GENERAL FUND (101) IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND (550); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND (505) TO THE COMMUNITY DISASTER RELIEF EXPENSE ACCOUNT (550.000.56010) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the central Ohio region, including the City of Whitehall, has experienced record-breaking amounts of rainfall as well as severe storm damage; and

WHEREAS, homeowners in the City of Whitehall have experienced unprecedented storm damage due to the severe storms; and

WHEREAS, an account titled "Community Disaster Relief" expense account has been created to support homeowners in mitigating various damages to their property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Council approves a fund transfer of one hundred fifty thousand no/100 dollars (\$150,000.00) from unappropriated monies in the General Fund (101) to the Community Development Trust Fund (550).

SECTION 2: The Council approves an appropriation from the Community Development Trust Fund (550) to the Community Disaster Relief expense account (550.000.56010) in the amount of one hundred fifty thousand and no/100 dollars (\$150,000.00).

SECTION 3: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the City for these funds for the purpose stated.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare, and for further reason is good and necessary to assist homeowners with basement flooding relief due to continuing unprecedented rainfall patterns; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
